OVERVIEW

IENH is a private school with Lutheran affiliations officially founded in 1832 by German immigrants, who found at the hills of Vale dos Sinos, in the city of Novo Hamburgo, the lands they were searching for to instill their values, culture and identity. As a religious school, through more than 185 years IENH has been shaping the main leaders of society, with intellectual potential in different fields. It is also a space for an education with Christian values and experiences that focuses on leadership, entrepreneurship and socio-environmental responsibility. We have three locations: Pindorama, Oswaldo Cruz and Fundação Evangélica, which offer kindergarten education up to higher education, making the school a well-known educational facility.

An innovative proposal at the Vale do Sinos region, from the year 2000 the Institution began to offer technical courses. In 2005, the Bilingual Curriculum was implemented (Portuguese – English) at Kindergarten and Elementary School, making IENH a pioneer in this area at Vale do Sinos. In 2006, IENH Languages was inaugurated, a center which offers German, English and Spanish classes. As an answer to community requests, in 2007, IENH also started offering Higher Education. In 2013, the institute set up Technical Specialization Courses and in 2014, IENH College was extended to provide postgraduate courses.

The Institution has a scholarship committee that analyzes the possibility of a scholarship and percentage of discount (50, 75 or 100%) dependent on the family's financial documents.

Curriculum

The curriculum is organized according to the Base Nacional Comum Curricular (BNCC, Brazil's national curriculum), which includes Portuguese, Mathematics, English, Physics, Chemistry, Geography, History, Sociology, Philosophy, Arts, and Physical Education. Along with that, the Institution has integrated the subjects Essay Writing and Spanish - offering non-optional classes, AP or similar.

The classes are 50 minutes long and there are a total of 200 school days in a year, divided into three quarters: February to May; May to September; September to December – this system is valid until the second year of High School. In third year, the class has around 185 school days, with the last quarter going until the month of November.

In the senior year of High School, the students do not have classes in December due to the exams required to join Brazilian Universities, like the Exame Nacional do Ensino Médio (ENEM).

In 2021, the school hosted a classifier for the Climate Science International Olympiad.

Grading System

Because its education is focused on university entrance exams, mainly the National Exam for High School (ENEM), IENH runs, during high school, exams and mock tests so that the students are able to get used to ENEM's style; having as an evaluation method in all quarters and every subject the Program of Systematic Evaluation (PAS), an exam with five questions from these tests for each subject, which is taken by students from eighth grade onwards.

In 12th grade, students take, together with the PAS, quarterly exams in the same format as ENEM, divided in four areas and having as their content everything that has been learned during the quarter:

- Human Sciences and their Technologies: History, Geography, Philosophy, Sociology
- Natural Sciences and their Technologies: Physics, Chemistry, Biology
- Languages, Codes and their Technologies: Portuguese Language, Foreign Language, Literature, Physical Education, Arts
- Mathematics and their Technologies: Mathematics

During the course of the school years, students have many ways to recover from low grades, such as extra work and free tutoring. Those who cannot achieve an average of 7 at the end of the year need to take a final exam which covers all of the content taught throughout the year, on the subject in question, to achieve the necessary average to pass. If the student, even after the final evaluation, does not achieve the necessary grade in a maximum of three subjects, they will have the option of passing but paying for tutoring for half of the next school year. This tutoring does not apply to High School Senior Year.

In the last few years, the Institution began to offer mock SATs for High School and mock PSATs for Elementary School, which can result in extra points in English and Mathematics, depending on the score received.

Standardized Test Results

In the 2020 edition of ENEM, the IENH presented the highest average between the public and private schools from the city of Novo Hamburgo; the exam has a maximum score of 1000 and the average achieved by the Institution was 649. In the essay, which has a separate score, the school got an average of 835,38 out of 1000; making the IENH the highest grader between the public and private schools from Vale do Sinos and Grande Porto Alegre. In addition, the institution got to the 13th position among schools with best ENEM essay score in the state of Rio Grande do Sul. From 2021 on, the National Government stopped publishing schools scores and rankings for ENEM.
